





After the judge schedules the case for mediation, a written decision is rendered to parties involved in the dispute.

CLAIM IS DENIED B

THE WCAB?

Parties have 30 days from the date of the Workers' Compensation Appeal Board's decision to file an appeal with the Commonwealth Court.

Injured worker notifies employer of injury within 21 days of an accident or 120 days from the date of injury or having knowledge of a work-related

illness or disease.

STEP 3



Compensation within 48 hours for

injuries resulting in death or seven days for injuries resulting in disability lasting more than one work day.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A CLAIM IS DENIED?

Injured employees can file a Claim Petition (LIBC-362) within three years

of the date of their injury.
